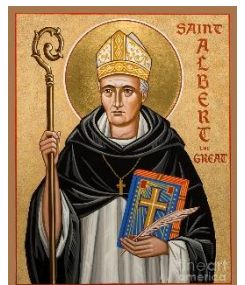

Tuesday 15 November
St Albert the Great, c. 1206-80 the Dominican theologian, who taught in Cologne, was called the 'Universal Doctor' for the vast range of his interests. Patron of scientists.



Wednesday 16 November
St Margaret, 1045-93, wife of Malcolm 111, King of Scotland, helped by her example and influence the work of reform in the Church. **St Gertrude, 1256-1302**, a Benedictine nun, from the age of 5 she cultivated devotion to the Sacred Heart and advocated frequent Communion.

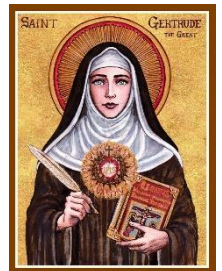
