The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

The Church of St John on the Lateran in Rome is 'Mother and Head of all the churches of the City and the World'. It is the cathedral church of the Bishop of Rome.

Thursday 10 November

St Leo the Great, elected Bishop of Rome 440, died

461, taught the two natures, human and divine, of Christ at the Council of Chalcedon, 451, and the primacy of the see of Peter.

Friday 11 November

St Martin of Tours, 316-97, Bishop of Tours, apostle of rural Gaul, founder of monasteries. Patron of France, soldiers, beggars and innkeepers.

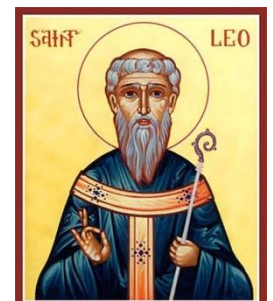
